### コラム 動詞と動詞を並べるときは? 単語表 stop 動詞のing形 より。

なぜ stop に続く動詞の形が ~ing 形なのでしょうか。2 つの動詞をそのまま並べると、日本語でも、 「遊ぶやめる」と変になりますね。「遊ぶことをやめる」のように自然につなぐために、英語では片方 の動詞を  $\sim$ ing 形(特に過去のことを表す場合)、もしくは to do 形(特に未来のことを表す場合)にし ます。この場合は stop に「これまで行ってきたこと(過去)をやめる」意味があるので、~ing 形が続 くと分かりますね。
